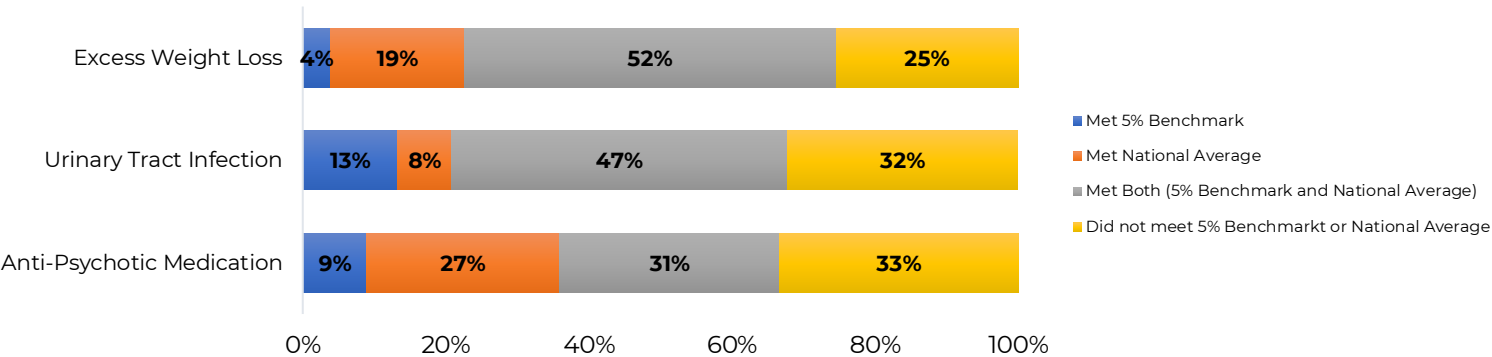
N024.02 Percentage of long stay residents with urinary tract infection.

N029.02 Percentage of long stay residents who lose to much weight.

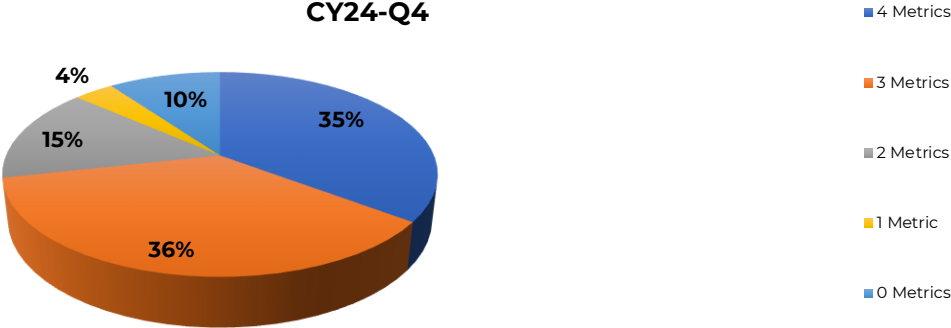

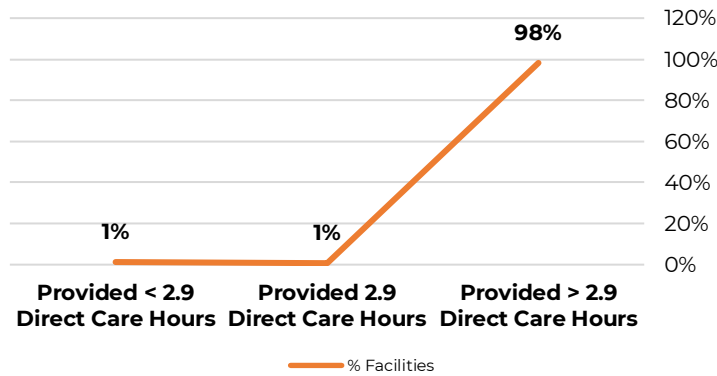

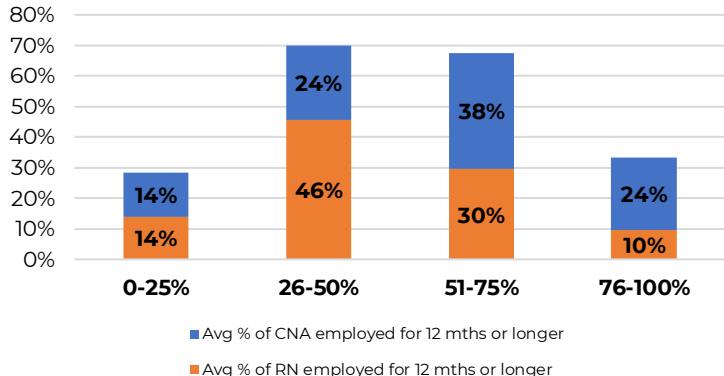
